San Joaquin County Receives Federal Census Data from the State Data Center, Will Begin Drawing New Supervisorial

This email is to provide you with an update on the San Joaquin County (SJC) redistricting effort. We have recently received the updated 2020 census data from the State Data Center and will be using that information to redraw the boundaries of the county's five supervisorial districts. This is a major milestone in the redistricting process! As a reminder, redistricting takes place every 10 years after the federal census, when district boundaries for federal, state, and local elected offices are redrawn to reflect new population data and shifting populations. This is important work because district lines can shape a community's ability to elect the representative of their choice. Read on to learn more about what this means for your community and how you can get involved.

We are hoping you can continue to share this information with your email lists, so that we can broaden our outreach to all the residents, municipalities, and community groups within San Joaquin County. Here are some resources to learn more:
