Completion of Redistricting

Late Census is complicating process

The current deadline for final passage of plans is December 15th as set forth in the FAIR MAPS Act.

- This deadline set by the Legislature may change.
- Need to proceed under the assumption that this deadline will not change as if you miss it, the courts will step in and draw the supervisorial lines.
- *We will be updating if/when there are any changes.*

From COI Testimony to Draft Maps

Working toward a recommended map for the Board

Our goal is to transition from outreach hearings to draft map creations to a recommended map for the Board. To achieve this Redistricting Partners will provide to the ARC:

- A summary of verbal COI testimony from outreach hearings
- An objective analysis of publicly submitted maps
- Drafts of consultant-drawn maps to ensure a range of options
- Requested changes by the RAC of maps

From COI Testimony to Draft Maps

September 29th RAC Meeting

Prior to the Outreach Hearing and to prepare for the first mapping meeting, in our next meeting Redistricting Partners will provide the RAC with:

- Updated data from the final the California dataset
- A summary of COI testimony collected and submitted
- Begin discussion on additional objectives to follow when drawing draft maps

From COI Testimony to Draft Maps

October 13th RAC Meeting

Prior to the RAC Meeting and to prepare for the first mapping meeting, we'll provide the RAC with:

- A summary of all COI testimony collected and submitted to the County
- A report on all public map submissions based on the following metrics:
 - Equal Population (deviation)
 - Confirmation of contiguity
 - Voting Rights Act Data (CVAP)
 - Neighborhood / City Divisions Report

From COI Testimony to Draft Maps

October 13th RAC Meeting – 1st Draft Map Hearing

This meeting will focus on publicly submitted and consultant-drawn maps, following the criteria discussed by the RAC in prior meetings. The focus of the meeting is:

- To identify publicly drawn maps that the RAC would like to elevate as a draft map or make changes to
- Review the consultant-drawn plans and their alignment to RAC goals and objectives

From COI Testimony to Draft Maps

October 27th RAC Meeting – 2nd Draft Map Hearing

This meeting will focus on reviewing the revised and amended maps from the prior meeting.

- All maps discussed in this meeting will be analyzed for total population, deviation, contiguity, VRA compliance, and neighborhood/city splits
- The RAC will make final changes to draft maps in preparation for recommending a draft map at the next meeting

From COI Testimony to Draft Maps

November 10th RAC Meeting – Final Draft Map Hearing

This meeting is to vote on and approve a recommended map to present to the Board of Supervisors on November 16th

- All maps discussed in this meeting will be analyzed for total population, deviation, contiguity, VRA compliance, and neighborhood/city splits
