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SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS SEEK MEMBERS TO SERVE ON VARIOUS BOARDS, COMMISSIONS, COMMITTEES AND EXTENDS THE DEADLINE TO SUBMIT APPLICATIONS ON PREVIOUSLY ANNOUNCED POSITIONS

Application Deadline is April 16

San Joaquin County - March 25, 2021 - The Board of Supervisors is seeking volunteers to serve on the following boards and commissions. The deadline to submit applications is **Friday, April 16**. The Board of Supervisors will consider qualified applications, received on or before the deadline, at the Board meeting of May 18, 2021.

All members appointed by the Board of Supervisors will be required to attend training. Training dates and registration information will be provided by the Clerk of the Board upon appointment.

• **Behavioral Health Board – 1 Position**

Qualified applicants must be a resident of San Joaquin County. Following successful appointment by the Board of Supervisors, appointees are required to submit a Form 700 - Statement of Economic Interest.

➤ One (1) General Interest Representative, Position No. 6704.4

• **Children’s Services Coordinating Commission – 1 Position**

If appointed, appointees are required to submit a Form 700 – Statement of Economic Interest.

• One (1) Fifth Supervisorial District Representative, Position No. 2005

• **Commission on Aging – 1 Position**

All members must live in San Joaquin County. If appointed, members will be asked to complete a Form 700 – Statement of Economic Interest.

➤ ***NEW*** One (1) At-Large Representative, Position No. 2306.2

- **Council for Quality Education and Care of Children – 1 Position**

All new applicants must complete a Supplemental application prior to being appointed and must attend one Council for Quality Education and Care of Children regular meeting within the 3 months *prior* to being appointed to the Council. Qualified applicants must live, work, or receive childcare services in San Joaquin County.

- One (1) Public Agency Representative, defined as person(s) who represents a city, county, city and county or local education agency. Position No. 2505.3

- **Lockeford Municipal Advisory Council – 1 Position**

Qualified applicants must be registered voter of the unincorporated area served by the Lockeford Municipal Advisory Council.

- One (1) Member, Position No. 4401.7

- **Redistricting Advisory Committee – 5 Positions** *NEW*

Members of the Committee shall be residents of San Joaquin County and reside in the supervisorial district for which they are appointed to represent.
